Monday	<u>Planning your dream</u> <u>WALT: plan ideas</u> Task – Have a look at the dream jar planning sheet with filled bubbles, showing my plan for possible dream. Then use the blank four questions sheet to plan your own ideas for your own dream. Dream jar planning sheet with bubbles (and example sheet)	<u>WALT: Recap Part 2 – Divide 2-digits by 1-digit</u> Watch the video for today and then complete questions on the worksheet. Monday Video Monday Worksheet	<u>Music</u> <u>WALT: associate music with mood and images</u> Listen to the pieces by John Williams from The BFG film soundtrack Dream Jars – YouTube Music Blowing Dreams – YouTube How does the music make you feel? (scared, relaxed, anxious, happy) How are the two pieces different? Task – Listen to 'Dream jars' again and let your pencil and imagination flow on a piece of paper. Draw some images/write some ideas about your 'dream'.	Self- Directed Activities (see google classroom) Listen to/read chapter 15 BFG – The Great Plan
Tuesday	<u>WALT: generate language choices</u> Task – Use the boxes on the sheet to plan your language choices for your dream. Think carefully about the use of commas in expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials. Dream jar planning sheet with bubbles for language choices	<u>WALT: Divide 2-digits by 1-digit Part 2</u> Watch the video for today and then complete questions on the worksheet. Tuesday Video Tuesday Worksheet	<u>SMSC</u> <u>WALT: understand what an aspiration is.</u> Stardust by Jeanne Willis, Illustrated by Briony May Smith – Bing video Discuss the questions on the task sheet with your grown ups. SMSC Tuesday 1st February sheet Task – create a poster showing all of your dreams and aspirations. You might use one of these for your English work. Wednesday	<u>WALT: draft writing ideas</u> Read the two examples of written dreams. Can you spot the fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and similes that have been used? Task – start creating your written dream on paper – working carefully to include your planned language choices. Remember you can edit your ideas, add parts into what you are writing to improve and take parts away if you do not like them. You are only writing one paragraph, so your sentences need to be the best they can be!
