2	<u>Look at the sentence challenge.</u> Improve the sentence and answer the questions. Write 3 or 4 more sentences about the picture. Think about using a variety of sentence types (simple, complex, compound, embedded clauses, relative clauses...)	
3	<u>Continue the story...</u> Read the story starter again. Write the ending. It should be a few more paragraphs - you might want to make a story mountain to plan your story before you write it.	
4	<u>Finish writing your story</u> , purple pen (it doesn't have to be purple at home!) Check for the simple things: capital letters and full stops, spellings (have you included any Y5/6 words?), commas...
