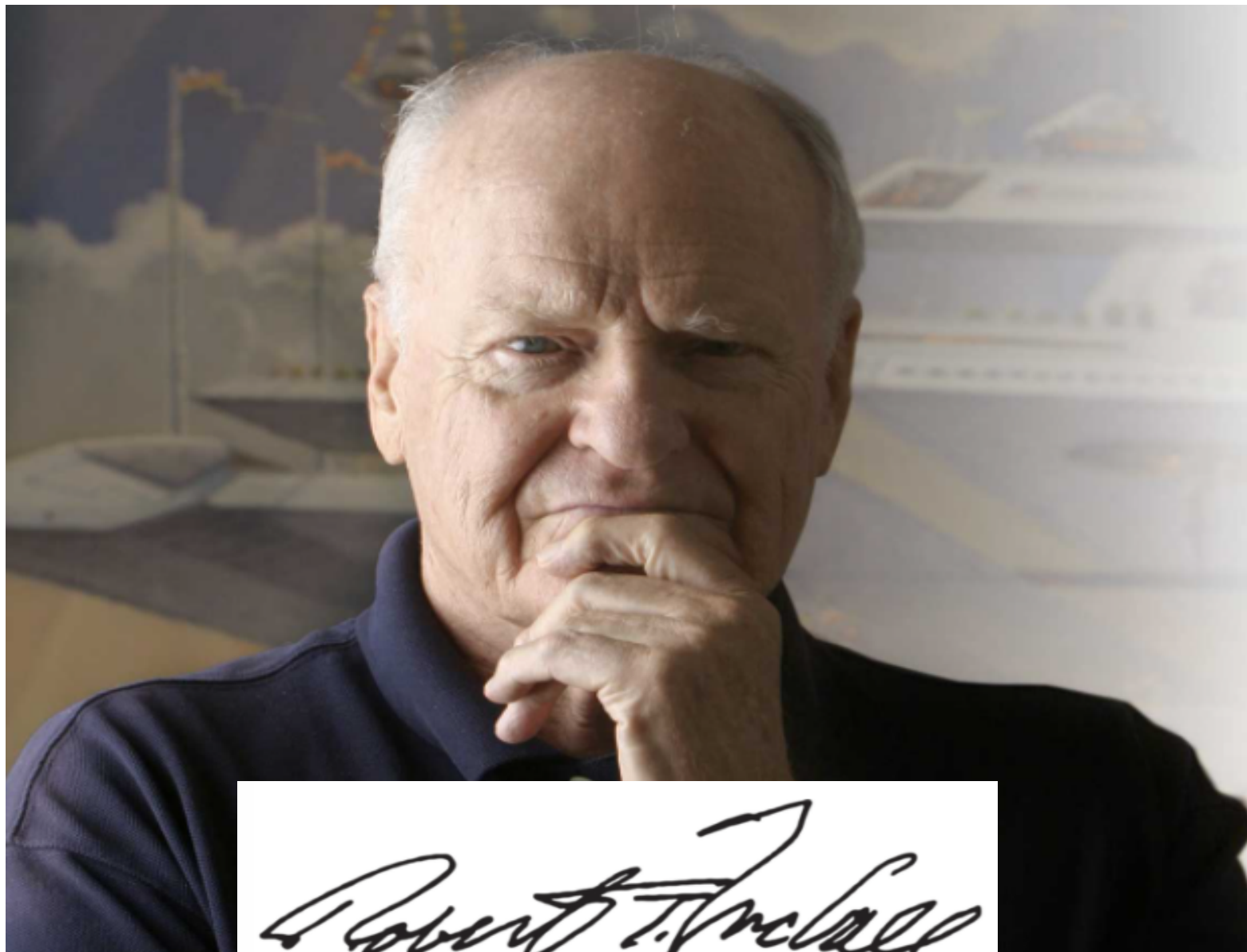

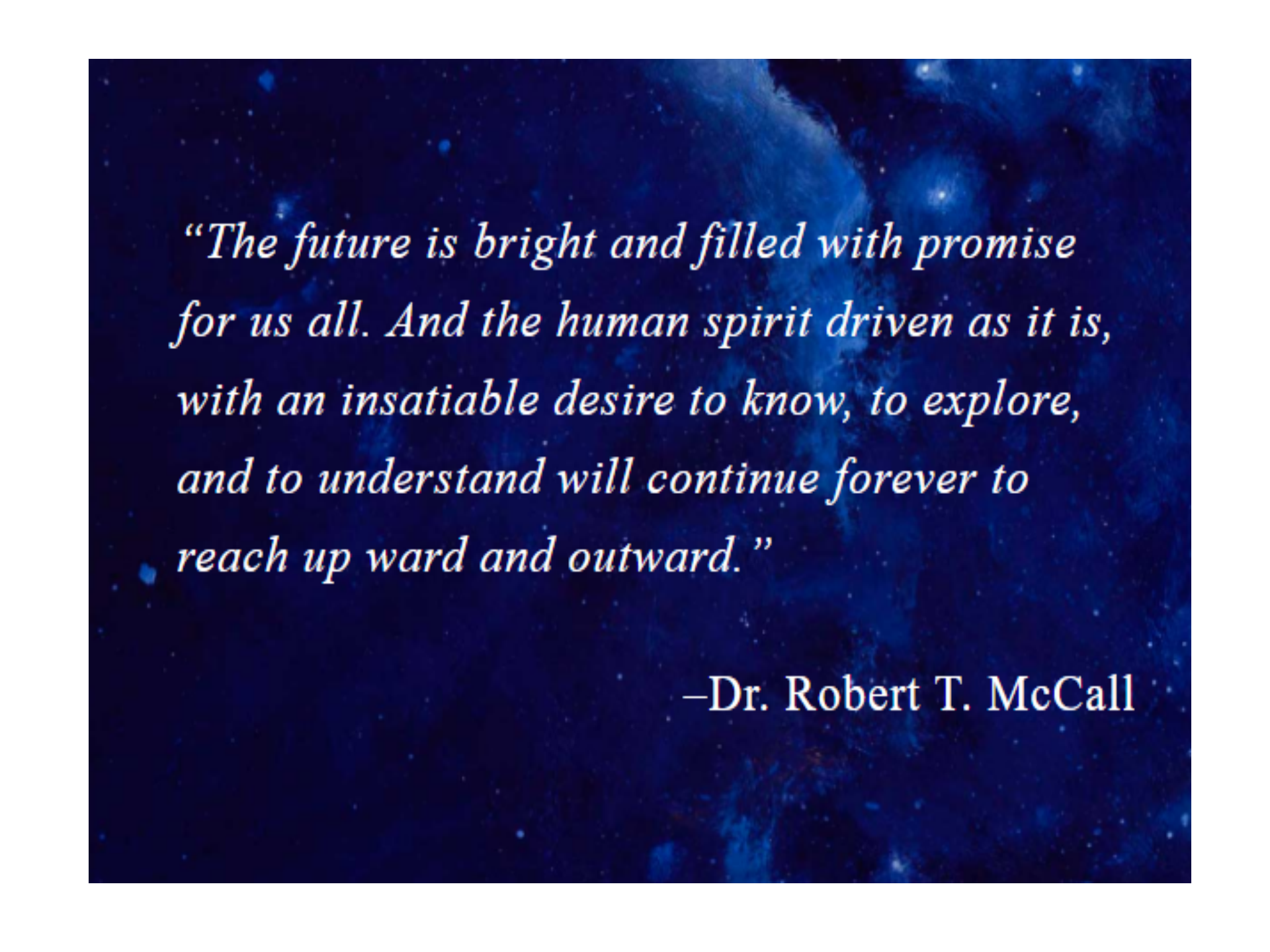

Robert T. McCall, Painter and illustrator

- Robert Theodore McCall (December 23, 1919 – February 26, 2010) was an American conceptual artist, known particularly for his works of space art. McCall was an illustrator for Life magazine, created artwork for the films 2001: A Space Odyssey and Tora! Tora! Tora! and worked as an artist for NASA, documenting the history of the Space Race. McCall was also production illustrator on Star Trek: The Motion Picture. McCall's work can be found on U.S. postage stamps, NASA mission patches..
