At 9am each morning, the work for the day will be made available for you to access in assignments on Google classroom. On the planner below, you will see an outline of the work for each day with the instructions in two columns, which tell you exactly **what you need to do** and **what we want to see** for each subject, each day.

You will find instructions, links to click on and any worksheets or videos that are part of that day's lesson. If you are not sure what to send us, remember to look at the planner below under the column **what we want to see** or see the instructions on each assignment.
