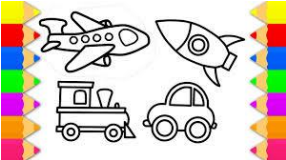
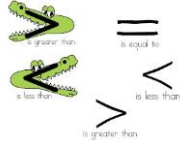

These are very bossy verbs and tell you to do something, they are at the start of sentence and turn it into a command. Watch the video 'bossy verbs making toast' and then watch the video of Miss Woodcock talking through imperative verbs. Can you order the instructions for getting ready in the morning and highlight the bossy verbs? There are two versions to choose from, which one suits you best? 	Would you like to name an alien? What name would you give the alien? Use the sounds to come up with some strange sounding names!	Digraph 'ay'. Have a look inside your books at home. Can you find words with the 'ay' digraph in? Have a go at sounding them out and blending them. 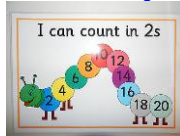
