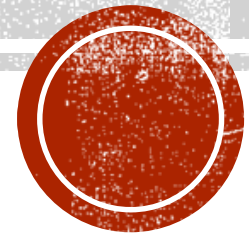


WHO LIVES IN A HOUSE LIKE THIS?

DAY 1

DAY 3 - SEQUENCING

- Can you remember the order of the story of Hansel and Gretel?
- Why not put on a play for your family and pretend to be the different characters?
- There are some pictures that are all jumbled up! Have a go at cutting them out and sticking them in the right order.
- Then you could add some sentences underneath to describe what is happening in that part of the story.

DAY 4 – DESIGN A SWEETIE HOUSE



- What is your favourite sweet or chocolate bar?

- What would you use for the roof and walls? Think of all the yummy sweets you could use for a window and door! What about inside? What would different things inside the house be made of?
- Why don't you have a go at designing your own house made of sweets?
- Maybe you could even have a go at making one!



DAY 5 – A NEW ENDING



- Read the story again until you get to the part where Hansel and Gretel are stuck in the house with the witch. What could have happened next? Can you think of a different ending?
- How could they have escaped from the witch?
- Is your ending a happy one?
- What different ways could they have tricked the witch?
- You could make a story map with your own ending or have a go at writing your own ending! Don't forget to send us any super work you do 😊
