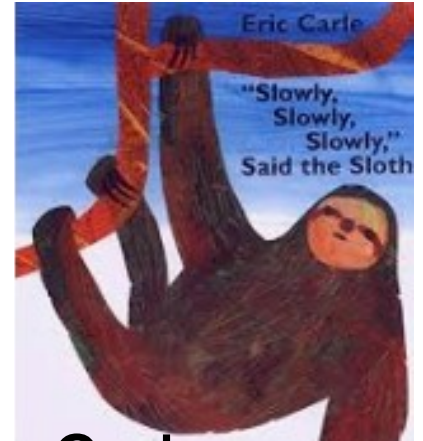


Eric Carle Artwork

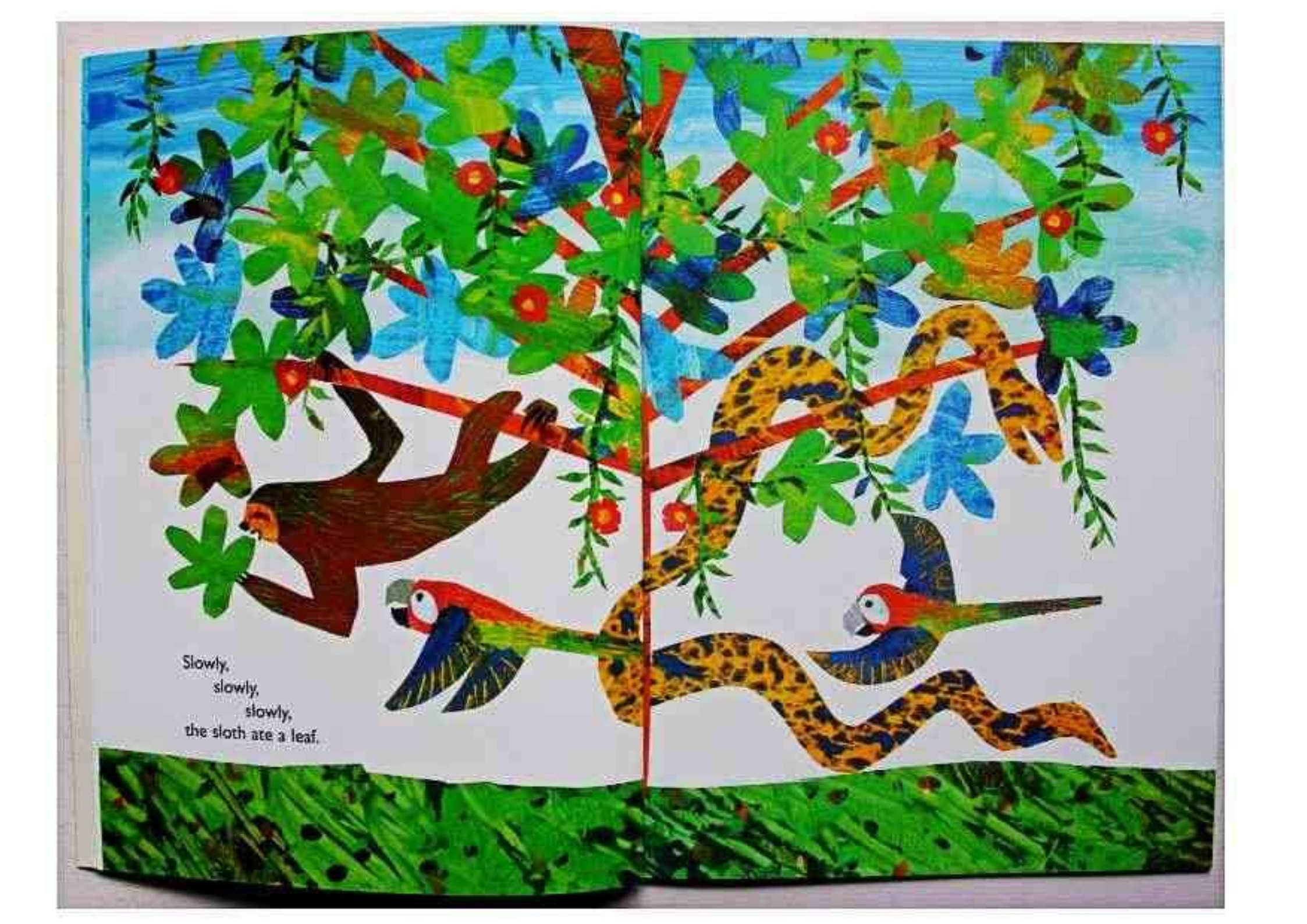

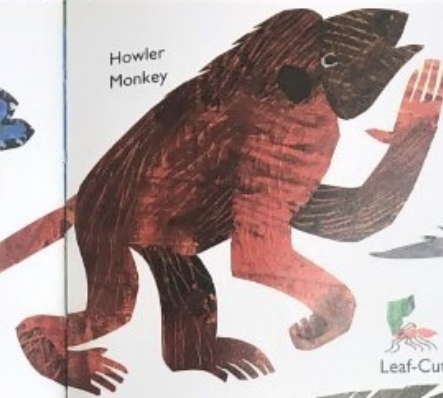

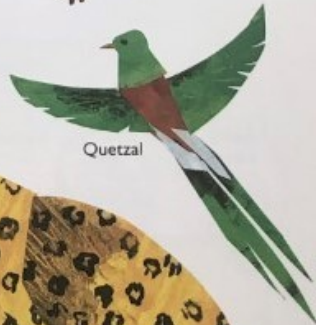
