Children are aware of the elements of SMILE that are incorporated into a lesson to support their learning

- The music scheme of work, developed by the subject leader develops skills from KS1 to KS2 and promotes culture, diversity and inclusivity. This includes the use of Charanga, BBC Music, Sing-up and Music Express.
- The interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch, dynamics, tempo, timbre, structure, texture and notation) are revisited in different year groups to allow the children to build upon prior knowledge and to recognise their own progression
- SMILE reflects our ethos and is central to the planning, delivery and assessment of our music curriculum. Children learn the importance of speaking, moving, imagining, learning and exploring.
- Where possible, cross curricular links are made with other subjects to embed learning and enhance musical understanding
- A range of extra-curricular opportunities are available for children including instrumental lessons, choirs, assemblies, concerts and whole school performances
