Our intent is for children to:

- ...listen to, perform, compose and improvise in a range of different styles and genres of music, including world music, popular and classical styles
- ...use the interrelated dimensions of music in KS1 and KS2 when listening to, performing, composing and improvising
- ...listen to and take part in live musical events to develop confidence and in form musical understanding
- ...be offered instrumental lessons in KS2 and encourage to use them to use their own instruments in whole class music lessons
- ...develop confidence using technical vocabulary to discuss musical extracts, performances and compositions. This includes the interrelated dimensions of music and identifying instruments correctly.
- ...be able to reflect on their own and others compositions and performances, offering specific points for improvement
- ...explore a range of musical artists, styles and genres enabling children to reflect on diverse communities and enable them to see themselves as having the potential to be musicians
- ...record performances in KS1 and KS2 to enable them to reflect on their own improvement and to empower them to be confident to make mistakes
- ...perform in a range of different ensembles and groups including whole school, whole class, small ensemble and solo, developing confidence and an enjoyment of music
- ...have opportunities to perform as part of their local and wider community throughout the year
