- ...be able to respectfully express their own ideas about the beliefs and values that have been exposed to.
- ...reflect on diverse communities and enable them to consider their own beliefs and values in relation to this.
- ...develop spiritually, culturally, socially and morally.
- ...engage in discussion, dialogue and debate which enables them to make their reasoning clear and which supports their cognitive and linguistic development.
- ...consider British values, including tolerance and respect for people who hold different faiths and worldviews.
