At Chuter Ede, we ensure our curriculum areas are delivered through our SMILE approach.



Children are aware of the elements of SMILE that are incorporated into a lesson to support their learning

- PSHE is taught through the Entwine PHSE curriculum
- The use of picture books enables children to develop empathy with a character to gain a greater understanding of the moral, message or learning point
- Planning encourages children to further their understanding of how they learn through the school's strategy of SMILE (I can: Speak, Move, Imagine, Learn and Explore)
- Assemblies share a consistent message relating to a PSHE objective
- RE lessons, visits from Reverend Louise and trips to local religious places encourage children to appreciate, respect and ask questions about different faiths and beliefs
- The DARE programme (Year 5) develops children's understanding of addictive substances, peer pressure and bullying behaviour
- Anti-Bully Week each year ensures a consistent message regarding bullying behaviour and how children can take responsibility for reporting behaviours
