*This child has moved onto a more detailed B squared assessment scale. When he began he was on development matters for writing which only begins at 22-36 months, it doesn't go any lower. The new assessment does and that is why the child appears to have gone backwards.

All children have made at least "good" progress, with the exception of 2 children who have only made satisfactory progress in maths with 3 points progress.

78% of our pupil premium children made the Good Level of Development (GLD) – higher than the percentage of children making GLD overall across the year group. One who didn't is SEN and looked after with severe developmental delay. The other has recently been adopted and is still impacted by emotional and behavioural concerns.
