

Key findings of Pupil Premium data and progress 2017-18

47 children in KSI&2 (2 are FSM and LAC)

- This year's cohort of PP children have increased their level of progress in reading compared to last year's cohort.
- The writing and maths progress of this year's cohort are very similar to last year's cohort (which is still a minimal difference in comparison to non PP).
- 2017-18 PP = 8.4% (11.3% inc Ever6)
- An overall trend over the past few years is that the progress gap between PP and nonPP is very minimal in relation to the percentage of children that are PP at Chuter Ede.
- An area that has tended to be flagged up due to less progress are the LAC.

End of KS2 data

- 15 children are pupil premium from the Y6 cohort (16.7% of cohort)
- The 4 Ever6 children reached age related expectations in all areas.
- There were 5 FSM children. 2 of these children reached age related expectations in all areas. 3 of these children did not reach age related expectations (due to SEN needs, social care support or moving to Chuter Ede).
- The 2 AAC children reached age related expectations.
- The 1 LAC child (also FSM) did not reach age related expectations – she also is on the SEN register.
- The 4 SC reached age related expectations (apart from one child in writing

End of KS1 data

- 10 children are pupil premium from Y2 (11% of cohort)
- There were 6 FSM children. 4 of these met age related expectations in all 3 areas. 1 child did not reach age related in maths (but this child has social care involvement). 1 child did not reach age related in any area (due to being on the SEN register and also being LAC)
- The 1 AAC child met age related in all 3 areas.
- The 1 LAC child (also FSM and SEN) did not reach age related.
- 2 of the 3 SC children met age related expectations in all 3 areas.
There was 1 child who didn't meet age related in all 3 areas.
