

Swimming review July 2022

Year 4 cohort

- 89 children in the cohort

Children who did not reach the expected standard of swimming 25m distance competently or LJ7 (however the majority did swim 25m unaided at some point).

- The Y4 children did not swim as Y3 children in the previous year (2020-21) as they would have normally due to covid restrictions and pool closures.
- The children swam for the full 18 weeks of Y4 (2021-22) and made huge amounts of progress.
- The number of children not swimming 25m competently is equal to that of the previous year (29/88 in 2020-21 Y4 cohort and 30/89 in 2021-22 Y4 cohort)
- The number of children not reaching end of KS2 expectation of LJ7 was slightly higher than the previous year.

Changes to expectations

- *School swimming informed me Sept 22 that the NCC learner's journeys have been adapted. Instead of 10 learner's journeys, with the expectation of children reaching LJ7, there will now be 6 learner's journeys incorporating all of the key swimming skills linked to the NC. There will be more of a focus on children being able to meet the NC objectives of swimming 25m+ confidently in a range of strokes and performing a safe self-rescue. This means that figures will be more accurately linked to the NC objectives as LJ7 expected higher skills and objectives to be met.*

Year 6 cohort 2021-22

Review July 2022

Records show that there are 22 children who did not achieve their 25m whilst swimming in Y3/Y4 and therefore left KS2 not meeting this expectation and 54 children who did not reach Learner's Journey 7.

Records show that there are 29 children who did not achieve their 25m whilst swimming in Y3/Y4 and a total of 53 children who did not reach Learner's Journey 7. Top up sessions have been booked for Summer 2023 to target these children when they are Y6 pupils.
