

Swimming review July 2021

Year 4 cohort

- 88 children in the cohort

Children who did not reach the expected standard of swimming 25m distance competently or LJ7 (however the majority did swim 25m unaided at some point).

- Swimming was majorly disrupted for this cohort of children.
- 4HB children swam as year 3 children only (Sept 2019-Feb 2020) but did not swim during y4 – therefore only swimming for 18 weeks of the normal 36.
- 4AF and 4SM swam for 1 week as year 3 children before pool closures due to Covid in March 2020. These children then only received 13 weeks of swimming in year4 again due to pool closures and Covid restrictions (Sept2020-July2021). These children received 14 weeks of their normal 36weeks.
- These children did make great progress in their lessons considering the significantly reduced number of weeks.
- Numbers of children not reaching end of KS2 expectation of LJ7 is significantly higher than previous years.
- Numbers of children not swimming 25m competently is significantly higher than in previous years.

Year 6 cohort 2020-21

Review July 2021

Records show that there are 7 children who did not achieve their 25m whilst swimming in Y3/Y4 and did not perform safe self-rescue in a range of water based situations confidently.

Year 5 cohort 2020-21

Review July 2021

Records show that there are 22 children who did not achieve their 25m whilst swimming in Y3/Y4 and a total of 54 children who did not perform safe self-rescue in a range of water based situations confidently (therefore not reaching LJ7). We will look into opportunities for these children to have extra swimming in spring/summer 2022 where space allows in the pool.
