

Swimming review February 2020 for July 2020

Year 4 cohort (swam since Feb 2019 to Feb 2020)

- 90 children in the cohort

Children who did not reach the expected standard of swimming 25m distance competently or LJ7 (however the majority did swim 25m unaided at some point).

22 children did not swim 25m competently (24% of cohort).

54 children did not perform safe self-rescue effectively (60% of cohort).

- The children above were sent a note home asking if their parents could take them swimming to continue developing their water confidence or look into providing swimming lessons for their child.
- We will look into opportunities when these children are Y5/6 for them to have some more swimming lessons at school (if there's space in the pool due to class sizes) if possible.

Swimming yearly review (Feb 2019-Feb 2020)

- The progress the children made was brilliant over the year.
- The numbers above are higher than the last few years which is no disrespect to the children's swimming skills and ability. Reaching Learner's Journey 7 is an aspirational target.
- In the spring/summer of Y3, there were so many children in the small pool who were under-confident and unable to lift their feet off the floor.
- In the autumn/spring of Y4, so many more children had progressed to the big pool showing much more confidence in the water and with their swimming ability.

Year 6 cohort 2019-20

Review July 2020

Records show that there are 16 children (18% of cohort) who did not achieve their 25m whilst swimming in Y4 and did not perform safe self-rescue in a range of water based situations confidently. Following returned forms (or no replies) from parents, 15 of these still are unable to swim 25m.

Year 5 cohort 2019-20

Review July 2020

Records show that there are 7 children (8% of cohort) who did not achieve their 25m whilst swimming in Y4 and did not perform safe self-rescue in a range of water based situations confidently. We will look into opportunities for these children to have extra swimming in spring/summer 2021 where space allows in the pool.
