

Swimming review February 2018

Year 4 cohort (swam since Feb 2017 to Feb 2018)

- 91 children in the cohort

(1 child joined Jan 2018, 1 child did not swim for emotional reasons linked to SEN)

Children who did not reach the expected standard of swimming 25m distance competently (however the majority did swim 25m unaided at some point).

- The children above were sent a note home asking if their parents could take them swimming to continue developing their water confidence or look into providing swimming lessons for their child.
- We will look into opportunities when these children are Y5/6 for them to have some more swimming lessons at school (if there's space in the pool due to class sizes) if possible.

Swimming yearly review (Feb 2017-Feb 2018)

- The progress the children made was brilliant over the year.
- In the spring/summer of Y3, there were so many children in the small pool who were under-confident and unable to lift their feet off the floor.
- In the autumn/spring of Y4, so many more children had progressed to the big pool showing much in the water and with their swimming ability.
- Children, who in Y3 would not more confidence lift their feet off the floor, could swim 1 length of the small pool (20m) unaided on their back and were beginning to swim on their front.
- The entire Y6 cohort (2017-18) achieved their 25m distance badge whilst school swimming in Y4 (2015-16).
