FAO-Critical Workers/ Parents + Carers of Vulnerable Children

Good afternoon!

We are now in a better position to share some details and information with you regarding the provision for your child/ren.

By now you should have been contacted by a member of the admin team to find out about your specific provision requirements. If you have not been contacted yet, please bear with. If you have not been contacted by the end of the school day then please contact us by e-mail:-

We are experiencing a high demand of Key/Critical worker places, more so than the first time around. I urge you to only take up a place if this is absolutely necessary. Whilst government guidance does state that only one parent needs to be a Key/Critical worker to access provision, I strongly ask you that if you have an appropriate adult at home, please keep your children at home.

If your child/ren have been allocated a place to access this provision, here are some things you need to know:-

- We will be operating from both sites. Both sites will open their gates at 8.45am and children will need to be collected at 3.15pm. If you'd like to collect your children earlier than this then just let us know on the day.
- Children are to wear school uniform. They will need a warm coat.
- You will be informed of days when your child/ren will need to wear PE kits.
- Children need to bring a water bottle and a snack each day.
- Children may bring their own stationery to school.
- Hot meals will be provided each day. These will be free of charge until the end of this week. From Monday if you usually pay for school dinners then this will be the case. If you do not usually pay for school dinners then there is no requirement to. Alternatively children may bring a packed lunch. A menu of the meals is not available at present. Please let the office know your intentions and make payment in the normal way.
- Provision in school will match the provision that those working from home are accessing.
