Multi-skills - Throwing and Catching

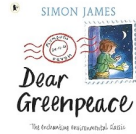
Including: throw underarm and over arm with good control and some accuracy, change position to catch an object

Continuous teaching of reading and application through VIPERS skills. (Vocab, Infer, Predict, Explain, Retrieve, Summarise)

Writing genres will include:

Spelling/Phonics

Phonics Level 6

The aim is for children to become fluent readers and accurate spellers. They will also learn: prefixes & suffixes, the past tense, proof reading and how to use a dictionary.

Maths

Throughout Autumn 1st and 2nd terms

Place Value

Including: recognise tens and ones, partition numbers to 100, write numbers to 100 in words, count in 2s, 5s & 10s, compare numbers, count in 3s, estimate on a number line

Addition and Subtraction

Including: addition & subtraction bonds within 20, add 10s, add 3 1-digit numbers, add & subtract across a 10, 10 more, 10 less, add two 2-digit numbers, missing number problems

Including: recognise 2d & 3d shapes, count sides & vertices, lines of symmetry, sort shapes, make patterns with shapes
