Multiplication and Division

multiply and divide by 10 & 100, related facts, multiply and divide a 2-digit and 3-digit number by a 1-digit number

Length and Perimeter

Measure in m & km, equivalent lengths (m and km), perimeters of rectangles and polygons

Fractions

Partition, compare and order mixed numbers, number lines with mixed numbers, convert mixed numbers to improper fractions & vice versa, add and subtract fractions

Decimals

Tenths and hundredths as fractions, decimals and on a numberline, divide a 1-digit & 2-digit number by 10 and 100
