Number - Decimals

Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths, dividing numbers by 10 or 100, solve money and measure problems involving fractions and decimals, convert between different units of measure (eg. km to m), compare numbers with the same number of decimal places, round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number and recognise and write decimal equivalents to one quarter, one half and three quarters.

Write money using decimals, convert between pounds and pence, compare amounts of money, estimate with money, calculate with money and solve problems with money.
