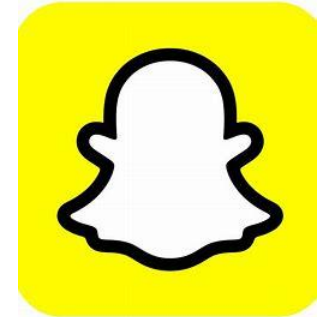

APP's

How old should you be to use WhatsApp & Snapchat?
User agreement states you should be at least **13YO!**

MEETME  MEETME IS A DATING SOCIAL MEDIA APP THAT ALLOWS USERS TO CONNECT WITH PEOPLE BASED ON GEOGRAPHIC PROXIMITY. AS THE APP'S NAME SUGGESTS, USERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO MEET EACH OTHER IN PERSON.	GRINDR  GRINDR IS A DATING APP GEARED TOWARDS GAY, BI AND TRANSGENDER PEOPLE. THE APP GIVES USERS OPTIONS TO CHAT, SHARE PHOTOS AND MEET UP BASED ON A SMART PHONE'S GPS LOCATION.	SKOUT  SKOUT IS A LOCATION-BASED DATING APP AND WEBSITE. WHILE USERS UNDER 17 YEARS-OLD ARE UNABLE TO SHARE PRIVATE PHOTOS, KIDS CAN EASILY CREATE AN ACCOUNT USING A DIFFERENT AGE.
WHATSAPP  WHATSAPP IS A POPULAR MESSAGING APP THAT ALLOWS USERS TO SEND TEXTS, PHOTOS, MAKE CALLS AND VIDEO CHATS WORLDWIDE. WHATSAPP USES AN INTERNET CONNECTION ON SMART PHONES AND COMPUTERS.	TIKTOK  TIKTOK IS A NEW MOBILE DEVICE APP POPULAR WITH KIDS USED FOR CREATING AND SHARING SHORT VIDEOS. WITH VERY LIMITED PRIVACY CONTROLS, USERS ARE VULNERABLE TO BULLYING AND EXPLICIT CONTENT.	BADOO  BADOO IS A DATING AND SOCIAL NETWORKING APP WHERE USERS CAN CHAT, SHARE PHOTOS AND VIDEOS AND CONNECT BASED ON LOCATION. WHILE THE APP IS INTENDED FOR ADULTS ONLY, TEENS ARE KNOWN TO CREATE PROFILES.
BUMBLE  BUMBLE IS SIMILAR TO THE POPULAR DATING APP TINDER. HOWEVER, IT REQUIRES WOMEN TO MAKE THE FIRST CONTACT. KIDS HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO USE BUMBLE TO CREATE FAKE ACCOUNTS AND FALSIFY THEIR AGE.	SNAPCHAT  SNAPCHAT IS ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR APPS IN RECENT YEARS. WHILE THE APP PROMISES USERS CAN TAKE A PHOTO/VIDEO AND IT WILL DISAPPEAR, NEW FEATURES INCLUDING 'STORIES' ALLOW USERS TO VIEW CONTENT FOR UP TO 24	KIK  KIK ALLOWS ANYONE TO CONTACT AND DIRECT MESSAGE YOUR CHILD. KIDS CAN BYPASS TRADITIONAL TEXT MESSAGING FEATURES. KIK GIVES USERS UNLIMITED ACCESS TO ANYONE, ANYWHERE, ANYTIME.
LIVE.ME  LIVE.ME IS A LIVE-STREAMING VIDEO APP THAT USES GEOLOCATION TO SHARE VIDEOS SO USERS CAN FIND OUT A BROADCASTER'S EXACT LOCATION. USERS CAN EARN 'COINS' AS A WAY TO 'PAY' MINORS FOR PHOTOS.	HOLLA  HOLLA IS A SELF-PROCLAIMED 'ADDICTING' VIDEO CHAT APP THAT ALLOWS USERS TO MEET PEOPLE ALL OVER THE WORLD IN JUST SECONDS. REVIEWERS SAY THEY HAVE BEEN CONFRONTED WITH RACIAL SLURS, EXPLICIT CONTENT AND MORE.	WHISPER  WHISPER IS AN ANONYMOUS SOCIAL NETWORK THAT PROMOTES SHARING SECRETS WITH STRANGERS. IT ALSO REVEALS A USER'S LOCATION SO PEOPLE CAN MEET UP.
ASK.FM  ASK.FM IS KNOWN FOR CYBER BULLYING. THE APP ENCOURAGES USERS TO ALLOW ANONYMOUS PEOPLE TO ASK THEM QUESTIONS.	CALCULATOR%  CALCULATOR% IS ONLY ONE OF SEVERAL SECRET APPS USED TO HIDE PHOTOS, VIDEOS, FILES AND BROWSER HISTORY.	HOT OR NOT  HOT OR NOT ENCOURAGES USERS TO RATE YOUR PROFILE. CHECK OUT PEOPLE IN THEIR AREA, AND CHAT WITH STRANGERS. THE GOAL OF THIS APP IS TO HOOK UP.

Some App's are even designed to hide the App's true purpose!

Some App's have settings that auto track you without you knowing!

When you share or post anything on the internet it stays there forever and can be accessed in the future!



Please follow these Safety Rules

- “KEEP PRIVATE INFO PRIVATE”
- “NEVER SEND PICTURES TO STRANGERS”
- “WHO IS IT FROM”?
- “ASK BEFORE DOWNLOADING”
- “DON’T REPLY TO ANY MESSAGES FROM STRANGERS”
- “SEEMS STRANGE, TELL AN ADULT”
- “NEVER ARRANGE TO MEET UP WITH STRANGERS”
- “NEVER ACCESS CHAT ROOMS WITHOUT PARENTS PERMISSION”
- “NEVER TELL STRANGERS WHERE YOU ARE OR WHERE YOU ARE GOING”

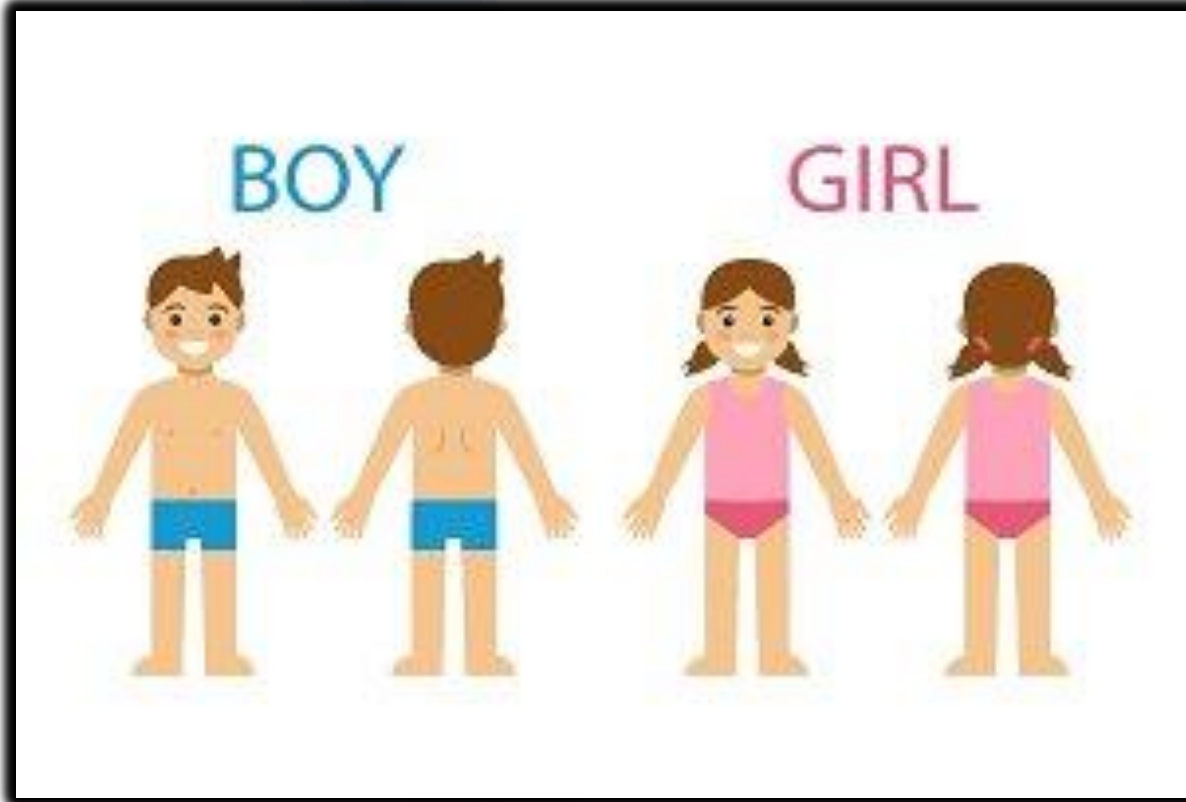
KEEP IT A SECRET <u>NEVER</u> Give Out Important Information Like Passwords, Your Full Name, Home Address, Or Phone Number	PERSONAL PHOTOS <u>NEVER</u> Send Out Pictures Of Yourself To Strangers	WHO'S IT'S FROM? <u>NEVER</u> Open Files From Websites You Don't Trust Or Open Emails From People You Don't Know
DOWNLOADING <u>ALWAYS</u> Ask an Adult First Before Downloading Something	DON'T RESPOND <u>NEVER</u> Respond to People Who You Don't Know Online	SEEMS WEIRD? <u>ALWAYS</u> Tell An Adult If Something Seems Strange Or If It Makes You Feel Uncomfortable
WANT TO MEET? <u>NEVER</u> Agree to Meet With Someone You Talked To Online and <u>ALWAYS</u> Tell An Adult If Someone Asks You To	CHAT ROOMS <u>NEVER</u> Enter An Online Chat Room Without An Adult Present	ONLINE STRANGERS <u>NEVER</u> Tell An Online Stranger Where You Are Going Or When You Will Be There
ALL ABOUT YOU <u>NEVER</u> Share Details About Your Life Such As Your Age, School Name, Sports Teams, Etc. With Anyone Online	BE NICE AND KIND <u>NEVER</u> Be Mean, Use Vulgar Language, Or Participate In Any Form Of Cyber-Bullying	MAKING PURCHASES <u>NEVER</u> Make An Online Purchase Without Adult Supervision And/OR Adult Approval



Private parts are Private!

Any part of your or another person's body that would be covered by a swimming suit is Private!

This means that it's illegal for anybody to take photos of these parts of someone body, especially if they are a child. It's also illegal for anyone to share or send them with others online or via message!!





Online Safety Recap

- **Never share your Name, Home address, School, Passwords or Mobile number with any unknown people online.**
- **Never arrange to meet with anyone you do not know or have met online without your parents being aware.**
- **Never take photos or make videos of yourself and share with unknown people online.**
- **Private parts are Private, and nobody should ever ask you for these types of images or videos. If anyone asks for anything like this then speak to your parents, teachers or us the Police.**
- **Never ask for images like these or share images like these!!**
- **Make sure you check with parents before downloading new applications.**
- **Make sure settings are checked on any app you have with your parents.**

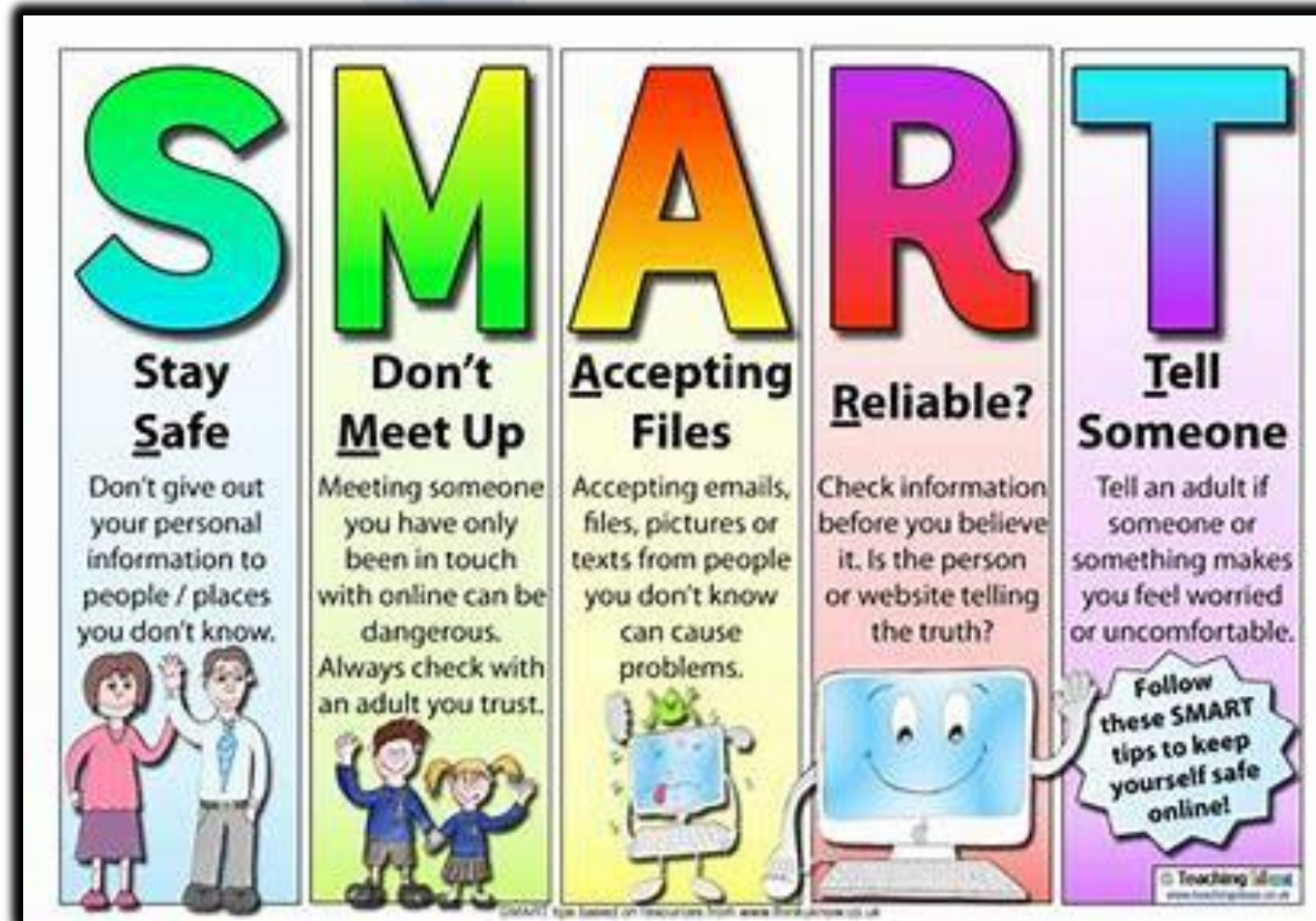
