So, what are we going to be learning about in the first term of Year 6?

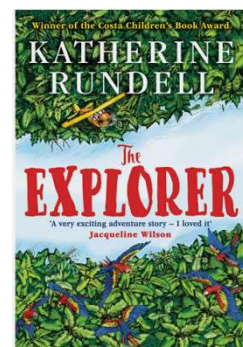
In the Autumn Term, our English work will be based around 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell.

We are going to learn about South America in geography and in history, we will investigate the Mayan civilisation. Our science topics will be 'Animals including humans' and 'Living things and their habitats'.

We will be studying the art of Frida Kahlo and using sewing skills in DT.

Maths will focus on number skills – consolidating all written methods of calculation and thinking about fractions, decimals and percentages too. There's also French, Music, RE, Computing, PE and PSHE.



We will be expecting you to be as independent as possible and be responsible for having the right equipment at the right time, completing homework tasks, reading at home and using TTRS and Spelling Shed lots too.
