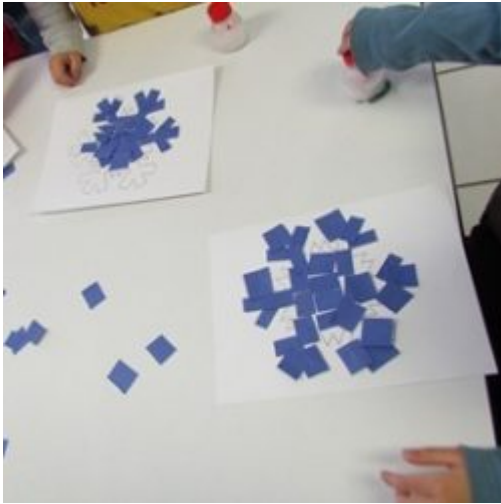




- Draw an outline of a snowflake.
- Using small pieces of paper your child can then collage over the top of the outline.



- Cut out small circles of white paper.
- You could use a stick from outside, straw, lollipop stick to then attach the circles to create the snowman's body.
- Decorate and personalise your puppet.



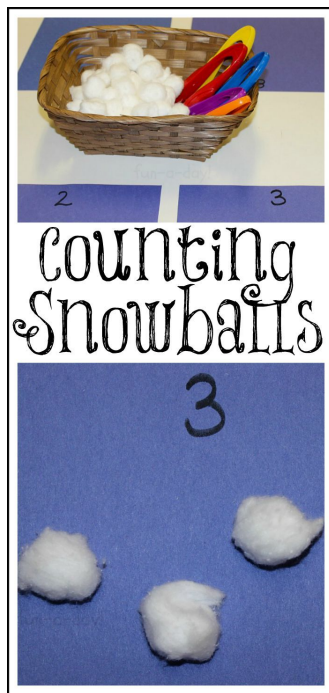
- These snowmen could be created by using a cardboard tube painted white or covered in white paper and then decorated.
- Alternatively you could roll some white card to create the snowman's body.



- This snowman has been created by using 4 strips of white paper to create each snowball.
- The 4 strips of paper are firstly glued into a flat star shape.
- Next take 2 opposite strip ends and glue together to begin creating a ball shape.
- Continue to do this until each paper strip end has been attached to another at the top.



- Using a semi-circle shape, your child could design and make a winter hat.
- If you have cotton wool, this could be added to make the bobble at the top.



- Using balls of cotton wool, crumpled up tissue or small round circles of paper ask your child to count out the correct number of 'snowballs' to match the numeral.
- If you have tweezers at home, these could be used to pick up the snowball and placed on the correct number.



- Create a snowman by using cotton wool or small crumpled up pieces of tissue.
- Add decoration to bring your snowman to life.
