Place Value

Including: representing, partitioning, estimating, comparing & ordering numbers to 10,000, find 1, 10, 100 or 1000 more or less, roman numerals, round to nearest 10, 100 or 1000

Addition and Subtraction

Including: add & subtract 1s, 10s, 100s and 1,000s, add & subtract two 4-digit numbers, checking strategies

Including: understand concept of area, count squares, make shapes, compare areas

Including: multiply & divide by 6, 7, 9 & 11, multiply 3 numbers
